Program In Radiography

Upon completion of the program, students will be eligible to sit for the American Registry of Radiologic Technologist (ARRT) credentialing examination. In addition to the ARRT, students will be eligible to apply for state licensure, which is a State of Illinois requirement as a condition of employment.

Students interested in becoming a radiologic technologist in Illinois or another U.S. state, state or territory, should inform themselves about licensure requirements in the state or territory in which they intend to live and work.
