Category Definitions/Racial Identity

- 2. **Asian**: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent, including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand and Vietnam.
 - 3. Black or African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
 - 4. Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.
 - 5. White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East or North Africa.
